U.S. Passport and Visa Guidelines

Travelers are responsible for obtaining their own valid passport and Egypt tourist entry visa.

Tourist entry visas may be obtained from Egyptian Diplomatic Bodies abroad, or from the Entry Visa Department at the Travel Documents, Immigration and Nationality Administration (TDINA). It is, however, possible for most tourists and visitors to obtain an entry visa at any of the major entry ports upon arrival for a \$15 fee, payable in U.S. dollars. Visitors arriving overland and/or those who previously experienced difficulty with their visa status in Egypt should obtain a visa prior to arrival.

U.S. citizens living or traveling in Egypt are encouraged to register with the nearest U.S. embassy or consulate at the Department of State's travel registration page in order to obtain updated information on local travel and security.

Apply for a U.S. Passport

You must apply in person if:

- You are applying for your first U.S. passport, **or**
- You are under age 16, **or**
- Your previous U.S. passport was issued when you were under age 16, **or**
- Your previous U.S. passport was lost, stolen or damaged, **or**
- Your previous U.S. passport was issued more than 15 years ago, **or**
- Your name has changed since your U.S. passport was issued and you are unable to legally document your name change.

Renewing Your U.S. Passport

Renew by mail if all of the following are true:

Your most recent U.S. passport:

- Is undamaged and can be submitted with your application.
- Was issued when you were age 16 or older.

- Was issued within the last 15 years.
- Was issued in your current name or you can legally document your name change.

If the above statements do not apply to you, you must apply in person.
